Credential Description: NCCER offers a complete series of entry- and journey –level assessments to evaluate the knowledge and skill level of an individual in a specific craft area. Carpenters make up the largest building trades occupation in the industry and those with all-around skills are in high demand. Carpenters are involved in many different kinds of construction activities, from building highways and bridges to installing kitchen cabinets. Carpenters construct, erect, install, and repair structures and fixtures made from wood and other materials. NCCER offers a four-level curriculum which covers content such as Building Materials, Cabinet Fabrication, and Advanced Wall Systems. Within each of the Carpentry Levels there are a number of modules to be completed. After each module examinees must successfully complete the module exam with a score of 70% or higher.
