Credential Requirements: The AutoCAD Certified Professional exam is a performance-based test. The exam is comprised of 20 questions. Each question requires you to use AutoCAD to create or modify a data file, and then type your answer into an input box. The exam has a 90 minute time limit. Candidates must also pass the AutoCAD Certififed Associate exam to earn the certification. Even though not required, it is recommended the student complete an Autodesk Official Training Courseware (AOTC) or equivalent plus 400 hours of hands-on application before sitting for the exam. Exam topics may include the following: Altering Objects; Annotations; Create Template Content; Creating Additional Drawing Objects; Dimensioning; Draw Organization & Inquiry Commands; Hatching Objects; Insert and Manage External References; Isolate or Hide Display Objects; Manipulating Objects; Layouts & Visibility; Printing & Plotting; and Reusable Content
